By the time children leave Tiny Teds, we intend for them to be able to.....

Shift tasks with support.

Understand action words.

Work on activities for a while.

Climb confidently.

Manage to share or take turns with others, with adult support.

Understand the terms, 'yours and mine.'

Peddle a tricycle.

Catch a large ball.

Show an awareness of number.

Enjoys sharing books with adults.

Make simple marks, including lines, curves and circular movements.

Use mathematical language in their play e.g., big, small, heavy, light.
